In cancellation of this Office earlier Advertisement vide Letter No. NCHG/D-436/Vol-II/2017-18/542-A Dtd. 20.01.2018 and , the intending applicants are requested to submit their application in Standard Form of Assam Gazette alongwith all required documents/particulars for the post of Block Level Facilitators (BLF) under MsDP in each of the 3 (three) Minority Concentrated Blocks i.e. (1) Harangajao Block (2) Mahur Block and (3) New Sangbar Block, fulfilling the eligibility criteria and terms and conditions and functions as below:-

The last date of submission of application is 5th March' 2018. No application will be entertained after the last date i.e. 5th March' 2018. Candidates who have applied earlier for the same post of BLF as per Advertisement vide Letter No. NCHG/D-436/Vol-II/2017-18/542-A Dtd. 20.01.2018 are also eligible to sit in the Written Examination as and when called for.

- Eligibility :- A permanent resident of Assam preferably residing in the particular Minority Concentrated Blocks (MCBs).
- Qualification :- Any Graduate with minimum 2 (two) years experience of working in Social Sector. Candidate having Degree in Social Work will be given preference. Diploma in Computer Application is also required.
- Age of the applicant :- Minimum 23 years and maximum 35 years.
- Remuneration :- Monthly salary of Rs. 13,000.00 (Rupees thirteen thousand) per month and maximum of Rs. 3,000.00 (Rupees three thousand) per month for TA/DA/Other Expenses.
- Category :- Unreserved.

Terms and Conditions :-

- 1) This engagement of Block Level Facilitator (BLF) is purely temporary and initially for a minimum period of one year.
- 2) This engagement is scheme specific. Depending upon the Centrally Sponsored Scheme (MsDP) and sanction & release of fund from Govt. of India, the engagement of Block Level Facilitator (BLF) will commence and continue.
- 3) Payment of remuneration will be subject to the release of fund from the Govt. of India, New Delhi.
- 4) The engagement may be terminated without assigning any reason if the performance is found not to be satisfactory.
- 5) The person can not claim any appointment/engagement under regular Govt. Establishment by virtue of his/her performing duties as a temporary appointee.

Functions :-

- 1) To function as a bridge between the Govt. Institutions and the minority community to ensure that the benefits of the programme will reach them properly.
- 2) To give necessary support to a Block Level Committee in scrutinizing the Plan and proposal for its recommendation to DLC and monitoring the implementation of the projects.
- 3) The facilitator will prepare the Progress Report and other report required for the programme.
- 4) The facilitator will also render necessary support to Social Audit Committee at the Block Level.
- 5) The facilitator would function directly under the control and supervision of the District Nodal Officer responsible for implementation of the MsDP.
